### Responding to issues in your community

During the month of March there were a total of 258 investigations in Woodbridge. This is a decrease from February where we recorded 264 investigations. (Investigations relate not only to recorded criminal offences, but also safeguarding individuals). Parishes have been affected by, residential / garage / shed burglaries, thefts from motor vehicles, criminal damage and ASB incidents. Investigations also include reassurance and crime reduction surveys.

We work closely with our partner agencies. i.e. ASB Team and Local Housing Authorities to provide advice and support to victims of crime and those affected by the ASB.
